B-給祝福(build for blessing 鼓舞祝福)、L-存愛心(listen for love 以愛傾聽)、E-做榜樣(enjoy for example 喜悅陪伴)，以孕育幸福力9元素。請學校協助交通食宿安排及提供服務之相關紀錄。
 3. 『台美加青年領袖 Family T. A. B. L. E』高峰會-活動旨在體驗國際文化異同，分享家庭價值觀，啟發公民意識，強化外語能力，開拓國際視野，同邁向幸福家庭與城市。本會負責邀請/培訓12位美加師生，規劃執行高峰會課程(純英文)。推薦出訪之學校協助相關招生與總務行政(手冊、證書、識別證)、場地與佈置，安排美加師生接待家庭與參訪(含中餐)、送美加學生至下一場。
 4. 全校宣導與推展國際「手足日」10大公約(附件三)

附件一：出訪學生之訪問心得-台中一中學生-王懷葳 2016.9.20 立法院分享

各位師長好，謝謝你們在繁忙中撥出時間來參加今天的活動。我是台中一中的學生王懷葳。我現在分享的是在這次出訪西雅圖的過程中我所看到、學習到的事情。

首先，我要從我的接待家庭開始講起，接待我的是一位有點年紀但是非常有活力的媽媽。她可是非常道地的美國人，跟我們無所不聊。她帶著我們從美國人的角度看美國的政治經濟社會，跟說我們說她對美國政府政策的不滿，在這次之前我去過美國兩次，不曾有人這麼做過，我深刻了解到甚麼是美國人民所想要的，體會到站在其他國家的人角度看事情的感覺。

再來，當我們去當地的教會時我們入境隨俗，跟著他們一起做禱告。他們祈求上帝照顧我們、給我們美好的未來、把我們當成他們自己的小孩、為我們祈禱。我是一個沒有信仰的人，但我深深地被他們的舉動所感動。向教會裡的人分享台灣的文化和習俗甚至是宗教時，我看見他們眼裡投射出的是一種被吸引感興趣的眼神，他們讓我們在耶穌面前講著佛教道教的歷史和習俗，這是需要多大的胸襟才能做到的事情，這讓我思考我自己是否可以以相同的態度去面對、去肯定不一樣的事物。

在與華盛頓大學的主任對話時，在我們問她問題後，她對著我們整個出訪團說：我們有太多對於美國跟美國人的刻板印象了。這讓我開始檢討自己為什麼會有那麼多先入為主的觀念，為什麼要對自己不了解的事物有偏見。

我們也有去參觀世界展望會，我被他們讓世界變得更美好的那股熱誠和完備的計劃和充分的執行力所深深感動，他們親自去當地了解人民真實的生活，也因為親自體會，在想解決之道時更能切中問題的根本，也許過程中遭遇許多困難，但他們從不放棄，透過團隊合作，一直以來不求名利，不求回報，努力地為這個世界做一點什麼，一點一滴慢慢地讓更多人幸福，讓更多人得到愛，我也希望自己以後有機會能如此的幫助別人。

而在與雷德蒙市長和市議會的對話中，我看到了為人民服務的熱忱，那種站在人民的角度去探討他們的需求是非常令人佩服的，同時他們也對我們所提倡的餐桌文化非常有興趣，雷德蒙市議長也承諾我們會在他們的會議中提出我們的餐桌文化來做討論，而西雅圖市的市議長和代表市長的市府國際部主任因為西雅圖與高雄市姐妹市，所以他們很關心台灣的政治，也很希望有一天能來台灣。西雅圖市議長對我們所提倡的餐桌文化非常有興趣，與我們有熱切的對話並合影留念。

我們在西雅圖會不定時，也許在戶外、又或者在接待家庭有聚會，比如說在美國很常見的 POT LUCK，這是西方很常見的聚餐方式，每個人或者每個家庭準備一道菜，聚集在一起享用、圍成一個圈，講話、講自己內心的感受。沒有字數限制，也不需用特別華麗的修辭去修飾我們的言語。我們只要把內心最真實所想的所體會的講出來。我們學會分享。更重要的，我們學會聆聽。不論我們講的長或短，普通或特別。不論我們字句是否有文法錯誤，他們總是很認真地去聽我們的每一個字，從不嘲笑我們的英文不好，從不覺得我們所講的是無聊平凡的。他們讓我們覺得自己是特別的是很棒的。從他們的眼神與回應，他們給我們鼓勵給了我們自信給了我們愛，反觀我們的國家卻很少有這樣的文化。

雖然西雅圖只是美國的一小區，也只是我們這次行程其中的一個地方，但在那裏我學到如何去肯定他人，我更了解要怎麼去尊重他人、學會用欣賞的眼光去看事情、學會怎麼互相合作幫忙、學會去感謝與讚美。

Reflection Report by Korey & Taylor Haug-Haapy Home World Alliance in Seattle

In my experience, people are not born great leaders, but rather shaped through their experiences and relationships along the way. I would go further and suggest that all of one's character is largely influenced by the culmination of experiences, words from authority figures, and situational advice given from a mentor. Through this mindset, I cannot speak highly enough about what these students experienced during their visit to Seattle through the efforts of Family TABLE and everyone in Seattle that helped to host.

Overall, everyone involved in hosting these students was so impressed by their maturity and emerging leadership qualities, and I have received numerous compliments from host families, city representatives, and business contacts that visited with the students. In particular, these students had such an eagerness and sincerity to learn and interact with our contacts. Throughout all of their experiences, they demonstrated a deep level of intellectual, emotional, and even spiritual curiosity through their dialogues with elected officials, professional humanitarian workers, and even on a personal level with a family counsellor. In every situation, these students had incredible respect for the individuals sharing their time and expertise and seized every opportunity to learn and absorb all they could. Of great significance to me is the overall impression that I got when the students reflected on all they learned about *service, leadership, relationship, and community, and how they were going to take these lessons home and share them in their own hometowns.*

In my own perception, the students were most highly impacted by two particular themes. The first came through an information session with a local representative. Here, the students learned the *importance of considering every individual and circumstances without preconceived notions or biases.* They realized how limiting and wrong their perspectives can be when confined to stereotypes about the way people or cultures can be. It takes great humility to be open-minded towards the unfamiliar, and this attitude was impressed upon them through many subsequent conversations as well. Secondly, a recurring theme of approaching adversity with the hope and optimism for redemption unified many of the stories and individual testimonies that we had through the week. We heard of people's hard, unfortunate circumstances that they were able to turn around and help make them stronger and better. And I honestly see this as a great humanistic lesson to learn: we will all face challenges in life, and there is always an opportunity to learn and grow from it. And I really think this is a life lesson that the students will internalize and can apply to any area of their lives.

Finally, I would not do Brandon Keun Chih Chang 張坤池秘書長 or these students justice without sharing the important lessons that I learned from them. From this experience, I feel like I learned a lot more about the Taiwanese culture and the incredible generosity and graciousness that you extend to one another. Even though these students didn't know each other or us before the trip, they were so compassionate and inclusive of each other. They made everyone feel important, valued, and understood, and through their inclusiveness, and there was an amazing environment of vulnerability and trust that I've never seen before from students their age. In all earnestness, my culture and I have a lot to learn from these students in the way of graciousness and interpersonal relationships. I am very thankful for this experience and it is something that I am now trying to incorporate into my life and character.

In final reflection, I have come to realize how important it is to share cultures with each other, and through this experience, I think everyone has expanded perspectives on family, community, leadership, and relationship. Thank you for your sponsorship and involvement to provide this to the young leaders of your country.
